

MPS Set of Four Competition 2019

SET OF FOUR COMPETITION 2019

- There are two categories -
 - Set The Four Elements Fire, Water, Air, Earth,
 - Open

Members can submit up to 2 entries, 1 in each of the 2 categories.

- This is a competition for digital images only.
- The format will be a set of 4 images that have a theme so that they work together as a whole, either sequentially telling a story, or as a set reinforcing the stated theme.
- The 4 images will be judged both individually and collectively. An image that is under standard will lower the entire set, so consistency across the images comprising the set is very important.
- Ultimately it is a "Set of Four". The whole should be greater than the sum of its parts.
- Digital enhancement of images is allowed with no restrictions; however, all images must be the work of the entrant captured on any type of camera.

Set Subject 2019 - THE FOUR ELEMENTS (Fire, Water, Air, Earth). This year's theme presents a challenge to 'think outside the box.'

Your set must include 4 images each of which represents one of the four elements, that is **ALL FOUR** (fire, water, air and earth) in one set, **NOT** a set made up of 4 fire images, or 4 water images etc.

- o To bring your set together, you might think about a consistent crop, a consistent colour palette, and a consistent object in the elements... or some other regularity that makes the set cohesive.
- o It definitely presents a challenge in both concept and photographic skill. But you can do it!

THEME (Both set and Open)

- ✓ The theme title is to be chosen by the entrant. "Untitled" is not an acceptable theme.
- ✓ The theme must be recorded at the time of entry.
- ✓ Relevance of the images to the theme title is essential as the images making up the set are intended to be judged individually and collectively.

MPS Set of Four Competition 2019 continued

ENTRY FORMAT

- There is no entry form, as all required information is supplied with the images.
- Entries are to be submitted by email to digital.manukauphoto@gmail.com
- Format; Image size to be a maximum of 1920 pixels wide and a maximum of 1080 pixels high, sRGB and jpg (the same as for Club night)
- 5 images are to be submitted; the 4 images that make up the Set of Four and a "5th Image" which is a composite of your 4 images.
- Each file name should be in the format;
 SOF19_Open_Joe_Bloggs_Theme_1 to 5 or
 SOF19 Set Joe Bloggs Theme 1 to 5

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Entries will have been judged prior to the display night, however, it is intended that the judge will be present on the night to answer questions and provide commentary.
- o The judge's decision will be final.
- There is no entry fee.
- o Entrants must be financial members of Manukau Photographic Society.
- o Images previously entered at club nights may form part of your set.
